A few thoughts from the Pastor:

The Feast of Corpus Christi celebrates the abiding presence of Christ palpably present in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar.

Christ comes to us as a thanksgiving gift that unites us to God in thankful praise. The Eucharist as celebrated during Mass is the perfect prayer of the Church. The Mass contains all elements of prayer (praise, thanksgiving, adoration, reparation and contrition) yet is eclipsed by the person of Christ acting through the celebration as Eucharistic Lord. The Sacrament in which the memory of Christ makes Christ present and alive for us is a Sacrament of the Church. It is Her memory and Christ comes to Her to share His life and redeem Her.

The Eucharist is therefore a communion for the life of the Church. It is our communion as the Body of Christ. It is our communion with the triune God. It is also our communion with the Saints in glory and those who have gone before us in faith. Let us bring this gift and communion to the world.
