## *A few thoughts from the Pastor:*

The readings today direct us to live the discipline of the law of love that has been planted in our hearts. The great prophets, including Ezekiel, constantly addressed Israel to turn from wickedness and seek God's righteousness. They gave no technical or schematic outlines how to accomplish this conversion except to proclaim the need to have absolute faith in God. It is only when our stoney hearts turn to flesh that this work may be fulfilled. A change of heart is a transformation of our personalities. True conversion changes us as people.

The Gospel today that first admonishes the sinner is to bring about this conversion so that the overwhelming love of God may gather us to accomplish His will for the world.

### Planning to be a Catholic Teacher?

It is critical for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic school board in Ontario, as part of your application for employment there must be a letter of reference from your pastor. If you (or if your adult child) is planning to apply to teach in a Catholic school, it is **highly recommended** you contact the pastor before Thanksgiving. 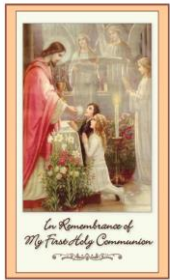


The EDGE is coming!
