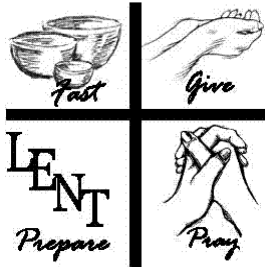

Pancake Day, or Shrove Tuesday, is the traditional feast day before the start of Lent on Ash Wednesday. It is the last opportunity to use up the eggs and fats before embarking on the Lenten fast and pancakes are the perfect way of using up these ingredients! The expression "Shrove Tuesday" comes from the word "shrive", meaning "absolve". Shrove Tuesday is observed by Christians who make a special point of self-examination, of considering what wrongs they need to repent, and what amendments of life or areas of spiritual growth they especially need to ask for God's help. A bell would be rung to call people to confession. This came to be called the "Pancake Bell" and is still rung today! Come join us for a Pancake Meal on Tuesday, Feb13th between 5:00pm and 6:30 pm.
