UPDATE ON OUR “NEWLY ARRIVED FAMILY”

The Kindeke family has been here for approximately two weeks. Family members consist of Boniface (father), Esther (mother), Boris (25 yrs.), Elvis (21 yrs.), Maria (15 yrs.), Beri (13 yrs.), Daniel (4 yrs.) and little Martin (11 mths.) The parish has rented the upper part of a house and through the generosity of parishioners, the Refugee Committee was able to fully furnish it and through “Acts of Love” have turned it into a home. The family is completely overwhelmed and overjoyed. To have lived in a camp in the bush with snakes...no fresh water...no electricity...and no food...is beyond anything they could have imagined. They are also very thankful for your donations of clothes.

The family now has their OHIP, SIN, children have been assessed and registered for school, etc. They have also applied for the Child Tax Credit which will take approximately 3 months. Maria has started grade 10 in high school. Beri, grade 8 and little Daniel, junior kindergarten. Boniface (father), Boris and Elvis, the two older sons are all actively looking for work. If you are aware of any company that is hiring, please call Pauline at the church office.

This weekend, Boris, the oldest son will be sharing with you a little about his life as a refugee for the past 12 years. We are asking you to please consider helping the parish with the financial support that is required at this time.

A second collection will be taken on the weekend of March 20th.
