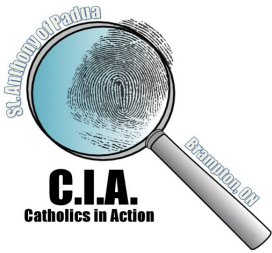

**GHANA MISSION - KRISAN REFUGEE CAMP**

St. Anthony Parish has accepted to sponsor a Congolese family of 7 who have been living in the Krisan Camp for 10 years. In an effort to continue our refugee assistance, we are preparing to ship a container to this camp on November 16. Here are some facts about the camp:

- There are 966 refugees of which 41% are children under 18 – that's almost **400 children!**
- There is little or no recreational/educational activity for out-of-school children.
- Malnutrition is a big concern.
- Help is greatly needed as there is no general food distribution in the camp



**St. Anthony's Parish is partnering up with Canadian Food for Children**

We are asking for donations such as:



- Food: rice, canned foods (lunch meat, vegetables, fruit, sardines, etc), jam, peanut butter, cooking oil in **plastic bottles** only, powdered milk, cereal, canned milk, hot chocolate **powder** only, cans of nuts, raisins, trailmix
- School supplies: lined paper, pencils, pens, erasers Hilroy notebooks, crayons, etc.
- Clothes: baby, children and adults
- Soccer balls, skipping ropes, bubbles, activity and story books
- Soap, shampoo, disposable razors, hand & body cream

## UNPACKING THE CREED...

"...and by the Holy Spirit, was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man. For our sake, he was crucified under Pontius Pilate..."

To refute the Gnostic claim that God had not taken on either human nature or a human body, the creed affirms that Jesus was born from a physical body of a virgin; he is seen as having his dual nature of Divinity and Humanity from his first moment of life. Note as well the role of Mary who cooperates in the work of the incarnation; she is an active participant in bringing God into the world.

There were many stories in the time of Jesus of mythical figures who performed miracles, who died and rose from the dead. To mention that Jesus died "under Pontius Pilate" a Roman prefect from 26-32 C.E. makes his death a historical event and takes it out of the realm of mythology.
