A few thoughts from the Pastor:

The revelation of the God who is love is displayed to the world in utter simplicity. The theological titles we develop to explain to our limited human intellect is a means to attain, through faith and reason, the communion and understanding of the God we know in Christ.

There are two ways in which we come to know the Trinity: One God in three persons. The first way is through the gift of baptism. The indwelling of the Holy Spirit impresses upon us the divine nature; we become divinized. We recall and live this gift each time we make the sign of the cross. It is the trinitarian life that leads to salvation.

The second way of knowing the trinitarian God is through contemplation. The eternal Godhead is worshipped. It is the praise of the angels and saints who adore God in prayer. The contemplative way of prayer that is centred on the God who is love, sweeps us into loving union with God. The great mystics including our beloved St. Anthony of Padua enjoyed this form of prayer to enjoy the sheer gift of God sharing His divine life with us on earth at it is in Heaven.
