A Very Warm Welcome to Paluku, Rose, Grace and Jonathan

Thank you, Jesus. Thank you, Jesus. Canada. Canada. Such simple words yet so very powerful. These are the words that Rose, the mom of our newest refugee family spoke as I drove her from the airport. With big eyes, she tried to take in everything around her. Both Rose and her husband, Paluku kept saying: "This is a miracle! God has truly blessed us. I must be dreaming!" After a small reception in our Parish Centre, we took our family to their new home. Through hard work and many "acts of love", the simple little two bedroom apartment that we had found for them was now transformed into a beautiful and welcoming "home". We watched as little Jonathan ran into his bedroom and grabbed a toy truck while his sister Grace climbed up the ladder to the upper bunk laughing. Rose threw herself on her bed and started laughing like a little girl. Later, she told me: "We have suffered so much so much...so much. We had no food...no clean water. Thank you, Jesus. Thank you St. Anthony's Parish. Our new family joined us for the first time to share in the Eucharist at the 5 p.m. mass on Saturday. Like Paluku said: "It is very far from the bush to here. God watched over us and has now brought us safely to our new home in Canada. Thank you Jesus."
