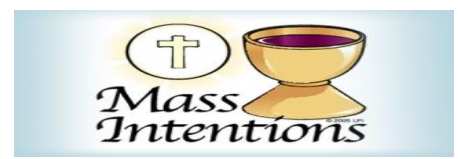
R.C.I.A. (RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS) (open to young adults - grade 9 and up)
