R.C.I.A. (RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS)

Rite of Election

On Sunday, February 14th at the 11:00 a.m. mass, the catechumens (non baptized) who are in the R.C.I.A. process confirmed their desire to be baptized at Easter Vigil, plus receive the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. Their sponsors and the R.C.I.A. Team affirm their readiness for these sacraments as they now begin the most intense weeks of their spiritual journey. This step (rite) is called "election" and "enrollment of names". The Church makes its election or choice to accept her people and declares that they are elected for Baptism, chosen to be God's own in Jesus Christ - not because they have earned it, but because God wants it.
