CHANGE IN PROCEDURE FOR ORDERING OF PAPAL BLESSING SCROLLS

The Vatican has recently announced that, effective January 1, 2015, Papal Blessings scrolls will only be available directly from the Vatican. Parishioners will be able to go on-line, download the order form and send directly to the Vatican by fax or mail. The scroll order will be processed and sent to the parishioner, along with an invoice for the scroll and shipping costs. Effective November 15, 2014, parishioners are directed to the Vatican website, www.vatican.va, under the Roman Curia tab, and then the Office of Papal Charities.



R.C.I.A. (RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS) (open to young adults – grade 9 and up)

What is R.C.I.A.? It is a process established for individuals (grade 9 and up) to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. This “*spiritual journey*” is centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded.
