The feast of Sts. Peter and Paul, June 29th, coincides this year with our Sunday celebration. It is such an important solemn feast that we honour this day with special devotion. It is also the great feast day for the city of Rome as both Peter and Paul were martyred and buried within her walls. It is a great feast for the universal Church because it is a celebration of the faithful apostolic foundation of the Church. The unity of the Church in her teaching and preaching is embodied by the lives of St. Peter and St. Paul. The apostolic succession that continues through the majestic Church that is centred in Rome causes us to rejoice that the Church and the world are guided by Church leadership that speaks with the authority of Christ under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Our prayers, united to the Church, centres us in the Church. When we pray as a church, Sts. Peter and Paul are with us no matter where we are located.

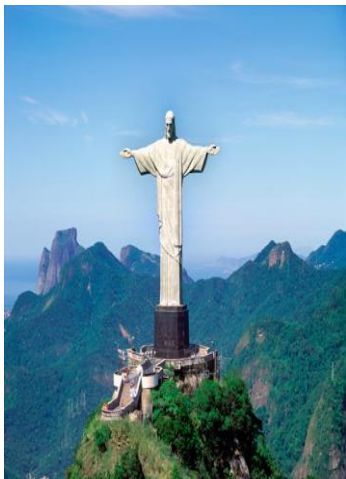
