OUR SACRAMENTS...

Anointing of the sick

The Anointing of the Sick completes our conformity to the death and Resurrection of Christ, just as Baptism began it. Over the centuries the sacrament was conferred primarily on those at the point of death (*Extreme Unction*). Today it is recommended for the seriously ill and the elderly.

Jesus designated the care of the sick to be a central task for his disciples (Mt 10:8), and he promised them divine authority for this purpose (Mk 16:17-18). It was the sick people who sought the presence of Jesus. They tried "to touch Him, for power came forth from Him and healed them all" (Lk 6:19).

The essential ritual by which the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is administered consists of a bishop or priest anointing the forehead and hands with holy oil, accompanied by special prayers. The sick person should be aware of what is happening.

The sacrament imparts consolation, peace, and strength to body and soul. The sick person unites their sufferings with Christ in a profound way and is able to battle the physical and spiritual challenges on their final journey. It also has the effect of forgiving sins (Jas 5:14-15). If circumstances suggest it, the celebration of the sacrament can be preceded by the sacrament of Penance and followed by Holy Communion. *Viaticum* (from the Latin "that which you take on the road") is the last Holy Communion that a person receives before dying. This helps them to pass over into eternal life. In eternity we will have only as much life as we are in union (communion) with God.
