
Living the Gospel by helping seniors maintain their independence

Celebrations livestreamed from the Cathedral Basilica of St. Michael, Toronto

Liturgies will be livestreamed so that the faithful may prayerfully unite themselves in their homes to each celebration.

Present at all the liturgies will be the priests of the Cathedral parish.

Palm Sunday Mass will begin at 10:00am. Blessed palms will be distributed at a later date.

Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper will begin at 7:00pm. Washing of the feet will be omitted. The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed in the tabernacle.

Good Friday Passion of the Lord will begin at 3:00pm.

Easter Vigil Mass will begin at 7pm. Lighting of the fire will be omitted. The Paschal Candle will be lit in the sanctuary.

Easter Sunday Mass will begin at 10:00am. Special prayers will be said for those affected by the current pandemic, for our religious and government leaders, and for the dead.
