4. All must leave the church right after the Mass or any other Ceremony due to the disinfecting. Please do not congregate at the church entrances

We are excited for all the children who will be receiving their First Holy Communion on the 12th and 19th of this month. Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals are now almost back to normal.
