Last year more than 700 Deaf people and their family members received help through Silent Voice.

Prayer and Procedure in place for Receiving “Act of Spiritual Communion”

Provided by Pope Francis

- Start with the sign of the cross
- Read a Scripture passage – Gospel Reading of the Day
- Acknowledge your sins and ask for forgiveness and pardon
- Have a real desire to be united with Christ
- Receive Christ in your soul and pray the *Act of Spiritual Communion*
- Offer prayer of Thanksgiving

Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.
