Coronavirus Update

Our team of clergy, staff and volunteers are committed to help direct/escort parishioners to their seats, give direction during Holy Communion, sanitize touch points after each Mass, and give instruction for exiting the church after Mass - all according to the Archdiocese of Toronto. Please note that as per government direction regarding capacity, churches are limited to **30%** of our worship space (240 persons inside our church).

Masks are highly recommended but not mandatory. Social distancing by 2 metres (6 feet) will be required.

We now have a reservation system, if you wish. It is not a must. If you want a reservation, simply phone the church office, leave your family name, Mass time, and the number of people. You will be given a reservation number. The reserved seating must be given away 10 minutes before Mass begins. So please arrive early! 905-793-8030

<u>All Masses have resumed as per usual Mass times</u>. Masks are highly recommended, **same household members may sit together**, social distancing is required, and no singing from congregation.

Please arrive no earlier than 30 minutes before Mass time. Church Office hours resume as before.

If you have a fever and/or are feeling sick, please do not attend church. If you are not yet comfortable in attending church, your Sunday obligation is not mandatory.

During this transition period, dispensation from the Sunday Mass will continue for those who may not be able to attend for health reasons or due to capacity restrictions.

During transition, Fr. Joseph Pham will continue with Sunday Mass on the **St. Anthony of Padua YouTube channel** for those who are unable to attend church.
