# Covid 19 and A Fair and Equitable Approach to Places of Worship – Fair and Equitable Treatment

You are invited to visit <u>aplacetoworship.ca</u> to respectfully share your concerns with your local Member of Provincial Parliament (MPP) and Premier Ford regarding places of worship and Covid-19 capacity restrictions. The province has relaxed restrictions in Grey (Lockdown) regions for retailers, allowing 25% capacity while places of worship can have no more than 10 people inside, whether they seat 100 or 1,000 people. Is this a fair and equitable approach?

Throughout the pandemic, places of worship have followed provincial restrictions and their own strict health and safety protocols. The most recent announcement eases the rules for retailers, allowing 25% capacity while places of worship are restricted to 10 people, regardless.

### Sunday Holy Communion Service Process 8am-2pm Guidelines:

Book your time only if you are receiving the Holy Eucharist as there is no time allowed for private prayer on Sundays.

You have to present your printed ticket or on a mobile device to the Usher. One ticket is required per person.

Arrive 5 minutes before your registered time slot.

Leave immediately after the service.

Mask or face covering is mandatory before entering the building. Observe all health guidelines, including social distancing at all times.
