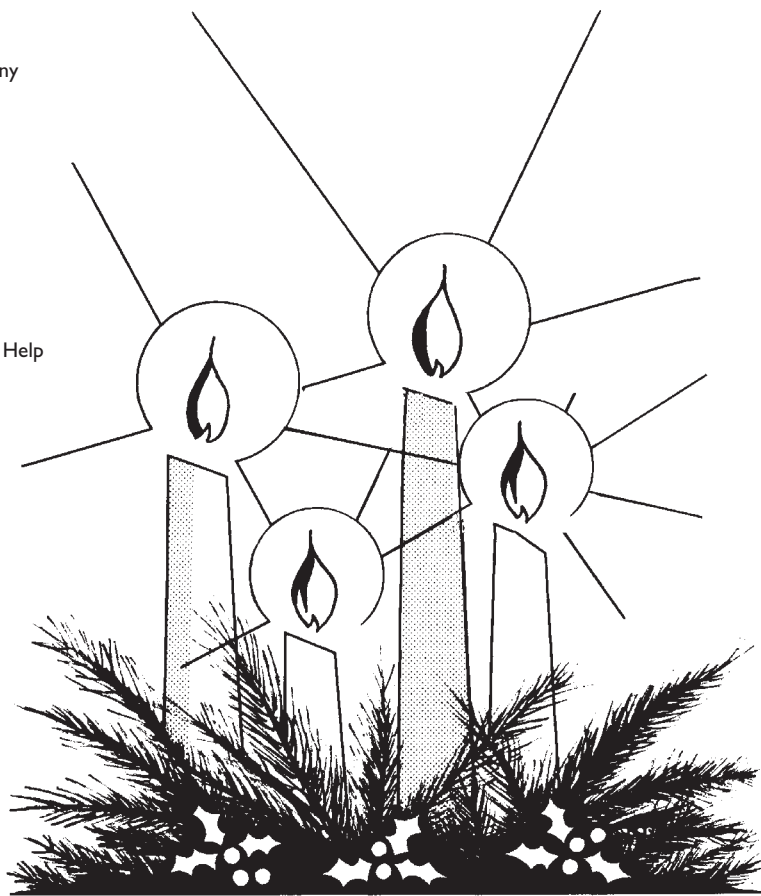

Baptism Preparation- Updated

Baptisms at St. Anthony of Padua parish take place every second and fourth Sunday of the month at 2:00 pm.

At least one parent must attend the two mandatory online classes.

Once you have submitted the forms, we will confirm with you the dates for the classes.

One godparent, male or female, is sufficient. Nevertheless, if your child is blessed with two godparents, then they must be one of each sex.

A Godparent must be at least 16 years of age and have received the sacraments of Baptism, Holy Communion, and Confirmation, according to Canon Law #873-874; and be in good standing with the Catholic Church. Please note that there is only one date for baptisms in December due to Christmas celebrations.
