WE ARE PEOPLE OF THE EUCHARIST!

(Excerpts from Deacon Daniel Slats' homily on the feast of Corpus Christi)

"This feast invites us to reflect deeply on the incredible gift of the Eucharist. This is a day to renew our awe and reverence for the sacrament through which Christ becomes truly present to us in the guise of bread and wine. This is what unites and strengthens us. We will never understand completely how great of a gift the Eucharist is - so great it is the only thing that we can offer to God. And when you realize you've done nothing to deserve this you realize how loved you are and that my friends are when the Holy Spirit grows and changes us.

In the Catechism of the Catholic Church 1324 "The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life. "The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch."

Ultimately, the feast of Corpus Christi challenges us to reflect on how we live our lives in response to this tremendous gift. Do we approach the Eucharist with the reverence and devotion it deserves? Do we allow the grace we receive to transform our lives, making us more Christ-like in our thoughts, words, and actions?

We are a people of the Eucharist! And because of this we need to spread and share that love, through our words, and even more so in our actions. Our faith needs to be practiced so it can be utilized and be seen in action."
